## Facilities to be made available in Private hospitals for starting Isolation Wards for admitting Influenza A (H1N1) cases.

Strict adherence to the infection control guidelines is essential to prevent transmission of infection between patients and from patients to health care workers and others.

- A separate ward for hospitalization of patients with a facility of separate entrance and exit.
- 2. Separate wards for positive and suspect cases with sufficient space.
- 3. Sufficient No of dedicated & trained medical and para-medical staffs for these wards.
- 4. Separate and isolated waiting hall or place for Out patients and relatives.
- 5. Sufficient No of ventilators should be available and trained staff to operate ventilators should be available.
- 6. At least one Physician should be available round the clock.
- 7. Dis-infection facility & bio-medical waste disposal Facility as per norm.
- 8. Trained personnel for collection of throat swab.
- 9. Separate room for staff and doctors.
- 10. Availability of separate ambulance.
- 11.Exhaust Fan
- 12. Toilet Facility Separate for Isolation Ward.
