HOW DOES NOVEL H1N1 INFLUENZA SPREAD?



- This virus is thought to spread the same way as the seasonal flu spreads.
- Primarily through respiratory droplets
 - Coughing
 - Sneezing
 - Touching respiratory droplets on yourself, another person or an object, then touching mucus membranes (e.g.mouth,nose,eyes) without washing hands.

GUIDELINES ON CATEGORIZATION OF INFLUENZA A H1N1

Category- A

- 1. <u>Mild Fever</u> plus Cough / Sore Throat with or without Bodyache, Headache, Diarrhoea and Vomiting
- 2. Treat, Monitor progress, reassess at 24 to 48 hours.
- 3. Patients to confine at home and avoid mixing up with public and high risk members in the family.

Do not require Oseltamivir or testing for H1N1.

Category-B

In addition to Category-A,

- (i) High grade fever and severe sore throat,
- (ii) One or more of the following
 - 1. Children with predisposing risk factors.
 - 2. Pregnant women;
 - 3. Persons aged 65 years or older;
 - 4. Patients with lung diseases, heart disease, liver disease, kidney disease, blood disorders, diabetes, neurological disorders, cancer and HIV/AIDS;
 - 5. Patients on long term Cortisone Therapy.

All patients of Category-B (i) and (ii) should confine themselves at home and avoid mixing with public and high risk members in the family.

Shall be treated with Oseltamivir: No tests for H1N1 is required

Category-C:


Category-A and B, with one or more of the following:

- 1. Breathlessness, Chest pain, Drowsiness, Fall in blood pressure, Sputum mixed with blood, bluish discolouration of nails etc,
- 2. Children with Influenza Like Illness who had a severe disease -red flag signs (Somnolence, High and persistent fever, Inability to feed well, Convulsions, Shortness of breath, Difficulty in breathing etc).
- 3. Worsening of underlying chronic conditions.


Require testing, immediate hospitalization and treatment.

H1N1 CASES & DEATH IN AMC


